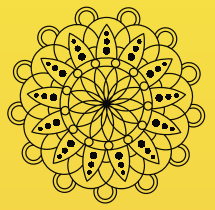
DUSSEHERA

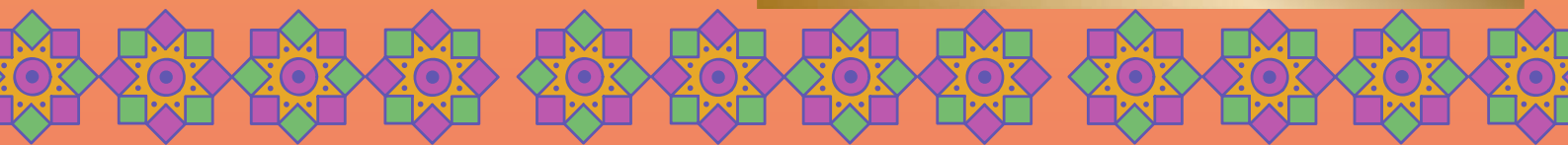
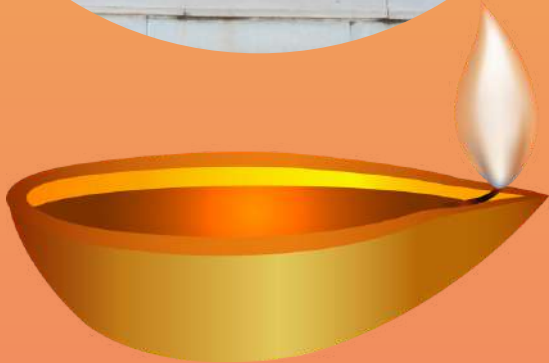




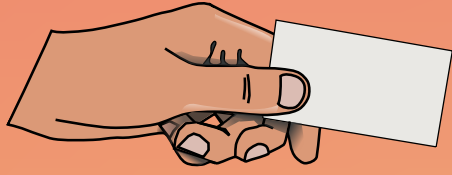
DIWALI CELEBRATION



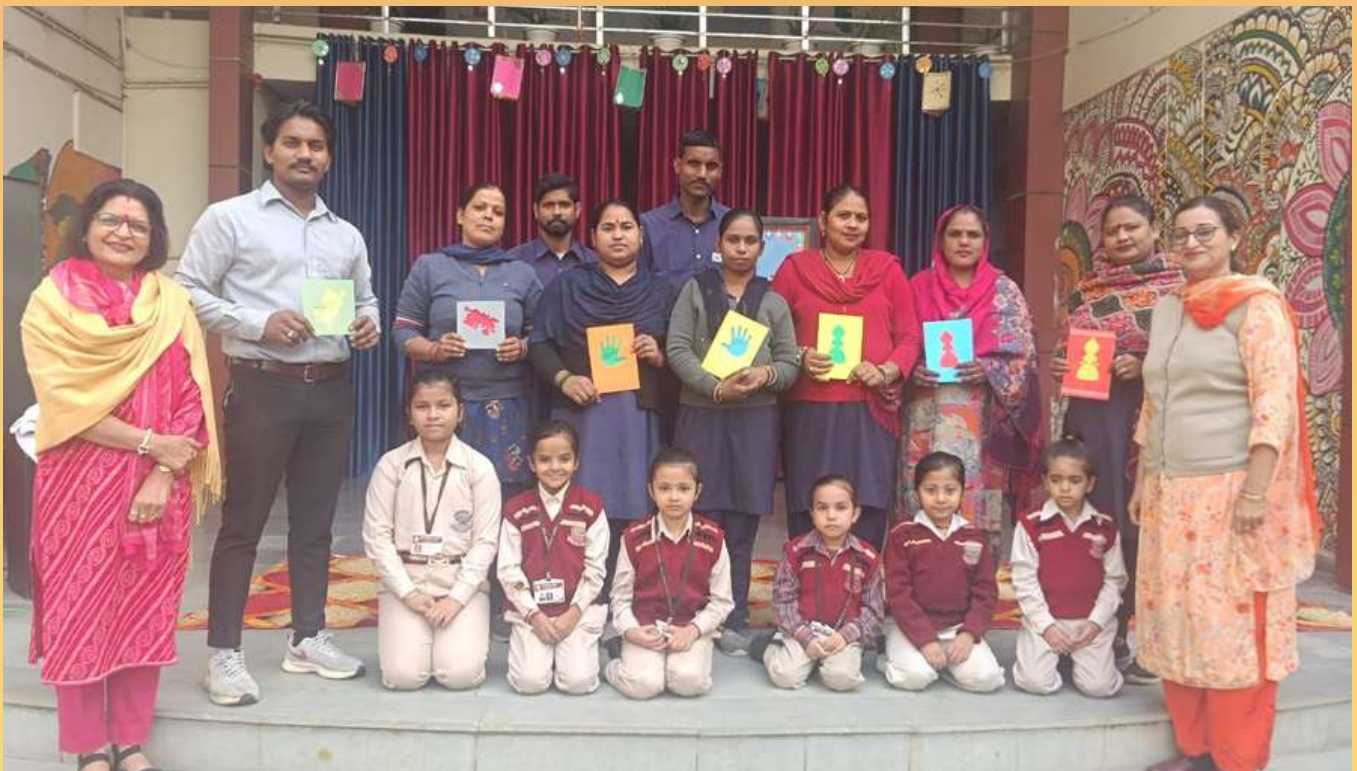

GURUPURAB



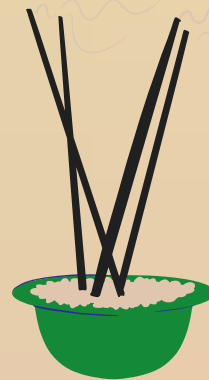

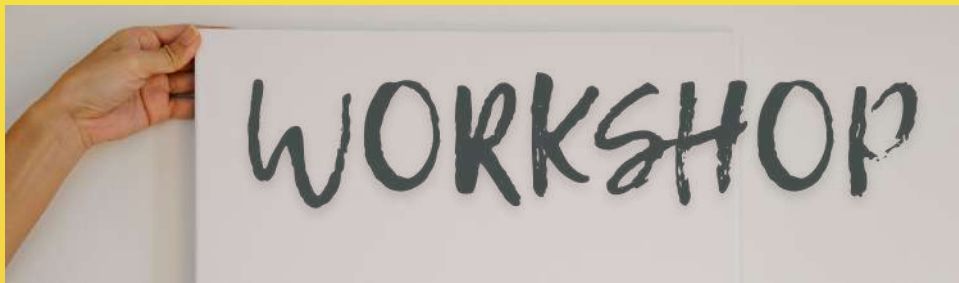
INTER HOUSE SINGING COMPETITION



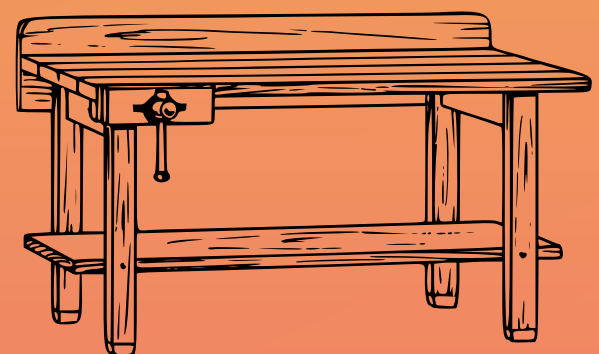

Road Safety CAMPAIGN

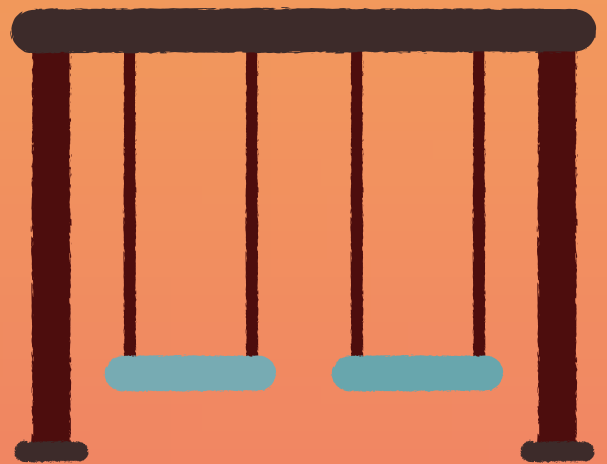
